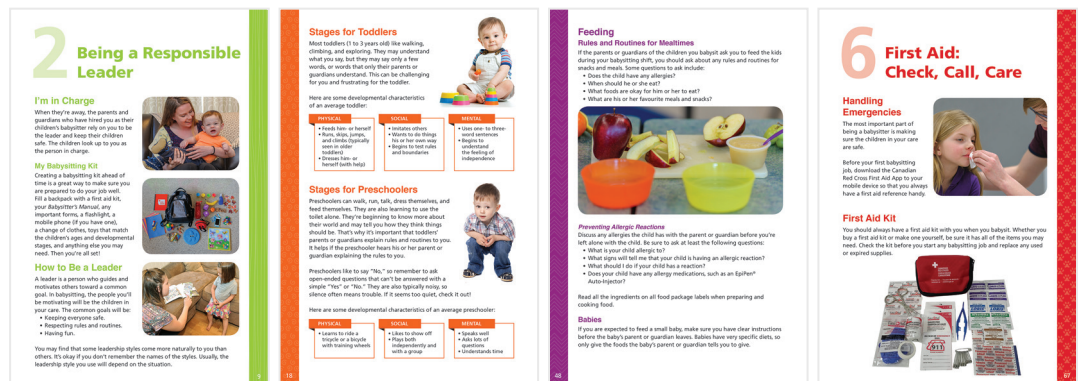
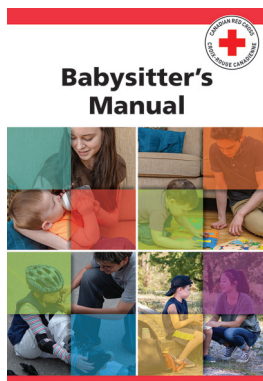
## COURSE CONTENT
