

Timberlea School Council Ambassador Program

The Timberlea Ambassador Program is a formal network of parents and caregivers that share their positive experiences at Timberlea Public School with the community.

When inquiries are made about registering students at Timberlea, people will be offered the option to speak with an Ambassador representing different aspects of life at Timberlea including:

- Grades
- Clubs (ie. Knitting, Drama, Archery)
- Sports (ie. Volleyball, Basketball)
- Activities (ie. MicroSociety, school gardens)

The Council Chair will maintain a list of people willing to share their Timberlea experience via phone or email. The chair will connect the person making the inquiry with the appropriate Ambassador, and let the Ambassador know that they can expect to be contacted.

Volunteers are asked to share their experience. If they don't know the answer to a question, they can refer back to the Council Chair or the school.

A call for volunteers will be done annually to keep the contact list updated and new Ambassadors can be added at any time.
