- grade 6: 25

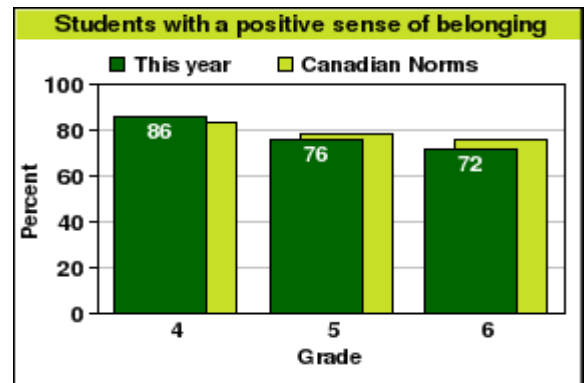

Social-Emotional Outcomes

Students with a positive sense of belonging

Students who feel accepted and valued by their peers and by others at their school.

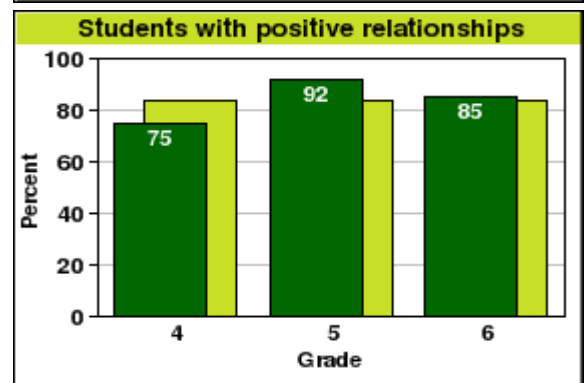
- 78% of students in this school had a high sense of belonging; the Canadian norm for these grades is 79%.
- 85% of the girls and 70% of the boys in this school had a high sense of belonging. The Canadian norm for girls is 78% and for boys is 80%.



Students with positive relationships

Students who have friends at school they can trust and who encourage them to make positive choices.

- In this school, 84% of students had positive relationships; the Canadian norm for these grades is 84%.
- 95% of the girls and 71% of the boys in this school had positive relationships. The Canadian norm for girls is 87% and for boys is 81%.



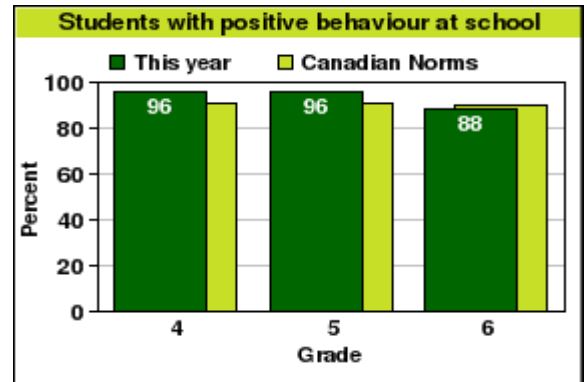


Social-Emotional Outcomes

Students with positive behaviour at school

Students that do not get in trouble at school for disruptive or inappropriate behaviour.

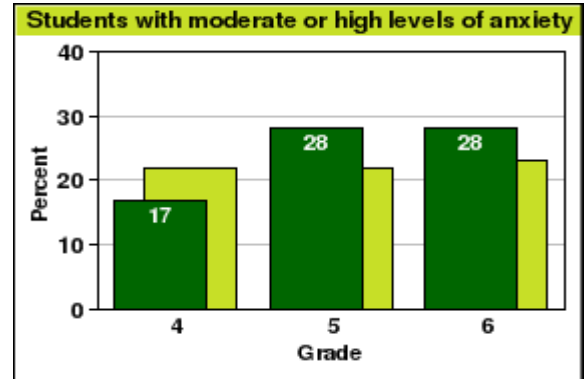
- In this school, 93% of students had positive behaviour; the Canadian norm for these grades is 91%.
- 100% of the girls and 85% of the boys in this school with positive student behaviour at school. The Canadian norm for girls is 95% and for boys is 86%.



Students with moderate or high levels of anxiety

Students who have intense feelings of fear, intense anxiety, or worry about particular events or social situations.

- 24% of students in this school had moderate to high levels of anxiety; the Canadian norm for these grades is 22%.
- 30% of the girls and 18% of the boys in this school had moderate to high levels of anxiety. The Canadian norm for girls is 26% and for boys is 18%.



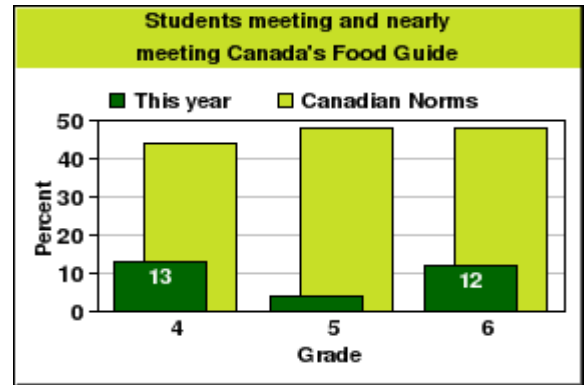


Physical Health Outcomes

Students meeting and nearly meeting Canada's Food Guide

The percentage of students that meet or nearly meet Canada's Food Guide.

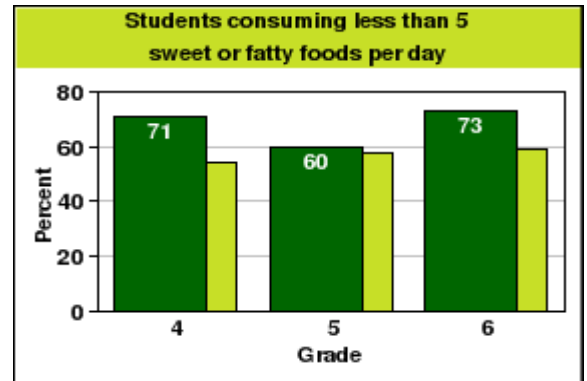
- 9% of students in this school met or nearly met Canada's Food Guide; the Canadian norm for these grades is 47%.
- 3% of the girls and 17% of the boys in this school met or nearly met Canada's Food Guide. The Canadian norm for girls is 46% and for boys is 47%.



Students consuming less than 5 sweet or fatty foods per day

The percentage of students that consume less than 5 sweet or fatty foods per day.

- 68% of students in this school consumed less than 5 sweet or fatty foods per day; the Canadian norm for these grades is 57%.
- 78% of the girls and 57% of the boys in this school consumed less than 5 sweet or fatty foods per day. The Canadian norm for girls is 61% and for boys is 53%.



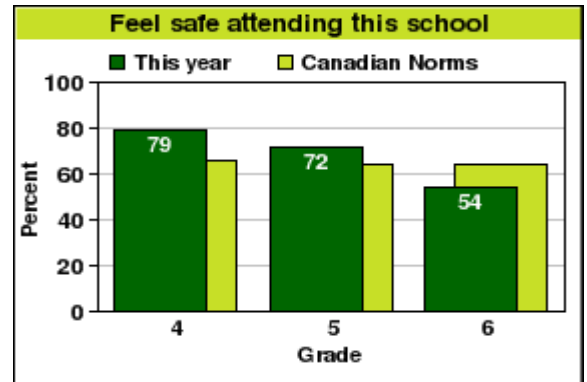


DRIVERS of Student Outcomes

Feel safe attending this school

Students who feel safe at school as well as going to and from school.

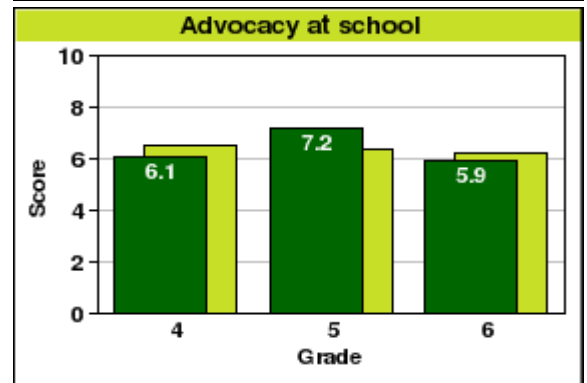
- 68% of students felt safe attending the school; the Canadian norm for these grades is 65%.
- 85% of the girls and 49% of the boys felt safe attending the school. The Canadian norm for girls is 66% and for boys is 64%.



Advocacy at school

Students who feel they have someone at school who consistently provides encouragement and can be turned to for advice.

- In this school, students rated advocacy at school 6.4 out of 10; the Canadian norm for these grades is 6.4.
- In this school, advocacy at school was rated 6.8 out of 10 by girls and 6 out of 10 by boys. The Canadian norm for girls is 6.4 and for boys is 6.3.



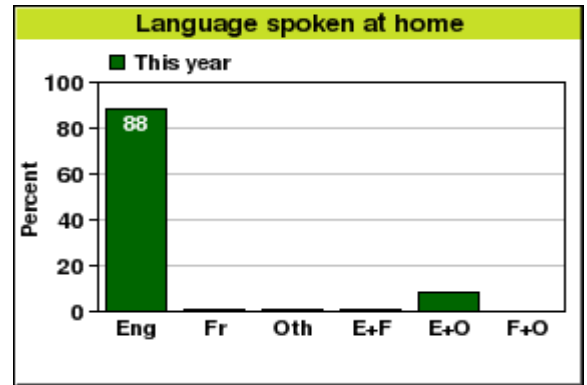


Demographic Factors

Language spoken at home

Students are asked to indicate the language they speak most often at home.

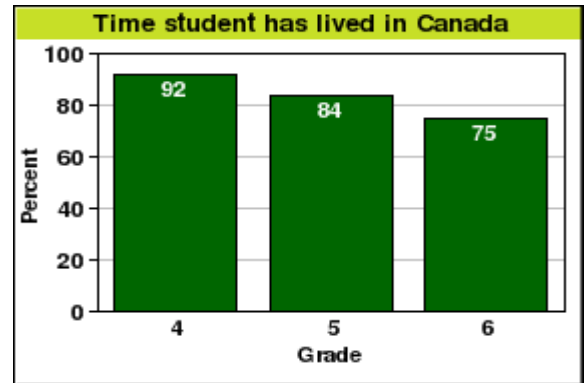
- 88% of students in this school speak English at home.
- 1% of students in this school speak French at home.
- 1% of students in this school speak other languages at home.
- 1% of students in this school speak English and French at home.
- 8% of students in this school speak English and another languages at home.
- 0% of students in this school speak French and another languages at home.



Time student has lived in Canada

Students who were born in Canada.

- 84% of students in this school were born in Canada.
- 85% of the girls and 82% of the boys in this school were born in Canada.



Indigenous Status

Students who identified as Indigenous, that is, First Nations, Métis, or Inuk.

- 22% of students in this school identified as Indigenous.
- 21% of the girls and 25% of the boys in this school identified as Indigenous.
